



VISIT BEAUFORT COUNTY

BATH

See St. Thomas Episcopal Church, the oldest church building in the state. Stroll the waterfront at Bonner's Point. Grab a hot dog or an old fashioned cheeseburger at one of the local grills. Learn about the notorious pirate, Blackbeard, at the

Historic Bath Site Visitor Center and Exhibit Hall. Call one of many local Captains to charter a relaxing boat ride or a fishing excursion. Finish your day with dinner at one of Bath's restaurants with a cold one in North Carolina's oldest town.



AURORA

Take a delightful ride on the Bayview Ferry on the east side of Bath to Aurora. A large phosphate mine in the area gives both paleontologists and fossil enthusiasts a unique opportunity to collect and study fossils from prehistoric times. The Aurora Fossil Museum, located in


town, includes a wide variety of marine fossils from the Pleistocene, Pliocene and Miocene eras, as well as Native American artifacts from the area. For lunch, savor a shrimp basket and a piece of lemon meringue pie from a nearby restaurant.



BELHAVEN

Located on the intercoastal waterway, you can wake up at your leisure and enjoy a nice breakfast at one of the B&B's..or have breakfast at a local diner. With a rich cultural heritage that spans over two centuries, Belhaven is home to eclectic shops and boutiques each offering a wide range of items, antiques, and curiosities that can't be found anywhere else. While shopping, take notice of the architecture of the buildings. There are several restaurants in the downtown area open for lunch. You can

find everything from country cooking to fresh seafood and a "beef sandwich." Tour the Belhaven Museum, open every day 1-5 p.m., except Wednesdays and Sundays. It's like no other museum you've ever seen! Experience the beauty and natural resources of the Pungo River/Pamlico Sound on a local charter boat or fishing venture. Drop by the Chamber office (open Tuesday-Friday 10 a.m. until 4 p.m.) and pick up your Tour of History and Trivia flyer. Dine in one of Belhaven's fine downtown restaurants.




PANTEGO

With a population of less than 200 people, Pantego is Beaufort County's smallest incorporated town, but it's got plenty of charm. The town sits on Pantego Creek, a tributary of the Pungo River, and is home of the Pantego

Academy Museum, where the rural eastern North Carolina way of life has been preserved. In town, there's a community park; just out of town, there's Terra Ceia Farms, world-famous for its tulip and peony bulbs that bloom in the spring.





EXPLORE OUR HISTORY

Aurora Fossil Museum

400 Main St., Aurora

Located in the town of Aurora, the Aurora Fossil Museum showcases 5- to 15-million-year-old marine fossils from the nearby Nutrien phosphate mine and Native American artifacts from across prehistoric North Carolina. The museum's mission to increase knowledge of the geology, paleontology and prehistory of coastal North Carolina is achieved through exhibits, interactive activities, outreach programs, events, field studies and the annual Fossil Festival. Children can dig for their own fossils, including sharks' teeth, at the fossil pit located across the street from the museum. Open Mondays through Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and Sundays, from 12:30 p.m. to 4 p.m. (from March 1 through Labor Day).

Belhaven Memorial Museum

211 E. Main St., Belhaven

This eclectic historic collection of Mrs. Eva Blount Way features many pieces of eastern North Carolina's past – Civil War and World War I uniforms, records, 19th-century clothing, old farming equipment and more. Open from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. daily, except for Wednesdays.

North Carolina's first town, and first port, Bath

was founded in 1705. Home to several historic properties and a visitors center with interactive displays, the Bath Historic Site allows visitors to talk a walk through colonial history – including the town's pirate history. Open Tuesdays through Saturdays, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Sundays, from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Historic Port of Washington Project

Step back in time and discover Washington's maritime past with this grassroots effort showcasing the waterfront trade that made Washington a thriving port. HPOW has displays set up in the Harbor District Farmers & Artisans Market, open Wednesdays through Fridays, from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., and Saturdays, from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Fauna and flora like nowhere else exist in the estuaries, where fresh and saltwater converge as rivers travel east to the Atlantic Ocean. The engaging, interactive and kid-friendly exhibits at the Estuarium let visitors of all ages experience the sights and sounds of the estuary and learn about the environmental challenges it faces. On free pontoon boat rides, guests can see the estuary in person, as well as take part in educational programs offered throughout the year. Washington Waterfront Underground Railroad Museum

A National Parks Service-designated "Underground Railroad Network to Freedom" site, this new museum shares a pictorial history of slavery and how Washington's waterfront was a road by river to freedom. Located in a restored Seaboard Coast Line Railroad caboose, a relic of Washington's past, the museum is open Thursdays and Fridays, from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Sundays, from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Washington Waterfront Underground Railroad Museum also has displays set up in the Harbor District Farmers & Artisans Market, open Thursdays and Fridays, from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Sundays, from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m.





P. S. Jones Museum of African-American Education



Vision loss is the single most prevalent disabling condition in the United States. A whopping 90% of it is preventable or treatable and yet fewer than 1 in 2 adults have had their eye health checked in the last 12 months.

The Blind Center aims to support our community by offering inclusive programming and services. Our expanded eye glass program has recycled no longer used eyewear to hundreds of people who could not have accessed eye wear otherwise. Our partnership with Lions Club International affords us the opportunity to schedule and staff mobile eye clinics for the rural areas of community, and our monthly hearing clinics reaches out not just to our members but to the community at large.

If you or someone you know is experiencing issues with vision and don't know where to begin this journey, have them call the center at 252-946-6208.

Our programming continues to grow with dedicated spaces for basket weaving, loom work, technology training, and open studio hours. There are many opportunities for volunteers to come out and do what they enjoy. If you have a special skill to share, call the center at 946-6208 or email Volunteer@theblindcenter.org.

Our newly added ENCight Gardens will support the need for fresh produce to address the growing rates of nutrition based health issues in our community. Hands on cooking curriculums created by a professional chef and blind adults ensures that participants know how to prepare their meals to honor their health and their tastebuds.







The James Adams Floating Theater docked in Bath in the 1920s. It was a virtual floating fun house and the inspiration for the best-selling novel *Show Boat*. Novelist Edna Ferber boarded the James Adams while researching her book and ended up working, eating, playing, and rehearsing with the company aboard. *Show Boat* was eventually adapted into a musical and three motion pictures.

BLACKBEARD MARKER

1 Hour

Walk in the footsteps of a pirate. Legend has it that Blackbeard (aka Edward Teach) was a tall, murderous pirate whose shiny black beard smoked when he walked. The infamous captain of the *Queen Anne's Revenge* settled in Bath after running his ship aground on a sandbar in Beaufort. Here, he received a royal pardon, which he promptly squandered by returning to the sea where he continued to rob and plunder with three pistols strapped across his chest. Skulk around the town he called home . . . before he lost his head in a bloody battle off Ocracoke Island in 1718.

LAWSONS WALK SIGN

1 Hour

Imagine mapping out a plan for your own town and picking where houses would be built and where the main street would lie. Think historical HGTV series, before there was HGTV or even TV. That's what John Lawson did for Bath. Lawson was a Naturalist, an explorer, and he was the Surveyor General for the Lords Proprietors. Known as the town's father, Lawson traveled the interior of the Carolina colony in the 1700s. He described the 550-mile journey in *A New Voyage to Carolina*, published in 1709. Lawson was killed by Tuscarora Indians while exploring the Neuse River in 1711.

HISTORIC TURNAGE THEATRE

1 Hour

Step inside the Turnage Theatre and you're transported back to the 1920s. Art Deco chandeliers illuminate the 432-seat theatre. A grand stage awaits the next magical performance. You can almost hear the cheers, laughter and applause of the audience. Visitors can tour the restored property by appointment. The Arts Council has transformed the space at the front of the theater into an art Gallery featuring the work of local craftsmen. So even when there is not a performance, there is always something creative to experience.

Though many have been "adopted" and moved out of town, you can still find six along the waterfront area, each decorated in a unique way.





CAN YOU FIND THEM ALL?

The 'Crabs on the Move' project started in 2006. The Pine Needles Garden Club started this venture as a way to give back to the community in Washington. The crab statues were auctioned off to different organizations and businesses at a 'Crab Ball,' a black tie event that was held at the Washington Civic Center. The money raised went to local charities. The crabs were painted and decorated by local artists, then displayed in town. At that time, the statues would be moved to different parts of town on occasion. Thus the 'Crabs on the Move' became the name of the initiative.

Project objectives included providing a marketing tool for tourism, raising money for local charities, tying in with the Estuarium's existing logo, providing an icon for tourists

and locals in which to identify Beaufort County, and bringing Beaufort County's first outdoor art exhibit to life - a showcase for our local artists.

The project eventually took a new direction when they were bought by various businesses, organizations, and individuals, (many were repainted) and were placed in permanent spots throughout Washington and Beaufort County.

Here is a list of the crab statues with locations and photographs for families, individuals and other groups can use as a type of 'scavenger hunt' to find and post your pictures.





Supporting the movement of people and things, Highway US 264 East/West is a four-lane divided highway that connects Beaufort County to Greenville and beyond to I-95 and I-40.

US 17 North/South is a four lane divided highway through Beaufort County and partially four-lane to parts of Norfolk, VA and Morehead City, NC.

The quickest way to Highway 95 is in Wilson, NC which is 65.4 miles away

PASSENGER AIR

KOCW Washington-Warren Airport (KOCW) exists to be a gateway to the City of Washington and Beaufort County, while being a beacon of premier service and hometown hospitality to the aviation community. This pilot friendly airport caters to General Aviation and is halfway between New York and Miami. They also offer rental car pick up and drop off, a well trained staff, convenient access to popular destinations and safety is a hallmark at KOCW! They also have short and long term hangars for rent.



PGV Pitt-Greenville Airport is located 26 minutes from Beaufort County and offers flights via American Airlines to Charlotte Douglas International Airport.

EWN Coastal Carolina Regional Airport in New Bern, NC is located 45 minutes south of Washington and offers flights via American Airlines to Charlotte Douglas International Airport and Delta Airlines to Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport.

RDU Raleigh-Durham International Airport is located 120 minutes from Beaufort County and provides over 400 daily flights via major US carriers with international flights to London, Paris, and Toronto.

WATERWAYS & ICW

The Washington Waterfront is along the north shore of the Pamlico River, approximately 25 nautical miles westerly from the Intracoastal Waterway, and 55 nautical miles from Ocracoke Island.

The channel from Red marker 16 in the Pamlico River has a normal depth of 9 to 11 feet to the Coastal Railway swing bridge. Inside the trestle, water depths run from 14 to 24 feet.
