

# Visit BEAUFORT COUNTY

# Bath

See St. Thomas Episcopal Church, the oldest church building in the state. Stroll the waterfront at Bonner's Point. Grab a hot dog or an old fashioned cheeseburger at one of the local grills. Learn about the notorious pirate, Blackbeard, at the

Historic Bath Site Visitor Center and Exhibit Hall. Call one of many local Captains to charter a relaxing boat ride or a fishing excursion. Finish your day with dinner at one of Bath's restaurants with a cold one in North Carolina's oldest town.



### Aurora

Take a delightful ride on the Bayview Ferry on the east side of Bath to Aurora. A large phosphate mine in the area gives both paleontologists and fossil enthusiasts a unique opportunity to collect and study fossils from prehistoric times. The Aurora Fossil Museum, located in

town, includes a wide variety of marine fossils from the Pleistocene, Pliocene and Miocene eras, as well as Native American artifacts from the area. For lunch, savor a shrimp basket and a piece of lemon meringue pie from a nearby restaurant.



# Belhaven

Located on the intercoastal waterway, you can wake up at your leisure and enjoy a nice breakfast at one of the B&B's..or have breakfast at a local diner. With a rich cultural heritage that spans over two centuries, Belhaven is home to eclectic shops and boutiques each offering a wide range of items, antiques, and curiosities that can't be found anywhere else. While shopping, take notice of the architecture of the buildings. There are several restaurants in the downtown area open for lunch. You can

find everything from country cooking to fresh seafood and a "beef sandwich." Tour the Belhaven Museum. open every day 1-5 p.m., except Wednesdays and Sundays. It's like no other museum you've ever seen! Experience the beauty and natural resources of the Pungo River/Pamlico Sound on a local charter boat or fishing venture. Drop by the Chamber office (open Tuesday-Friday 10 a.m. until 4 p.m.) and pick up your Tour of History and Trivia flyer. Dine in one of Belhaven's fine downtown restaurants.





# Pantego

With a population of less than 200 people, Pantego is Beaufort County's smallest incorporated town, but it's got plenty of charm. The town sits on Pantego Creek, a tributary of the Pungo River, and is home of the Pantego Academy Museum, where the rural eastern North Carolina way of life has been preserved. In town, there's a community park; just out of town, there's Terra Ceia Farms, worldfamous for its tulip and peony bulbs that bloom in the spring.








#### **VISIT THE ESTUARIUM**

Visit the world's first Estuarium, one of North Carolina's most innovative environmental centers at the heart of Washington's wetlands and wildlife. Over 200 exhibits describe its vital estuaries and coastal rivers, including: aquariums with crabs, alligators, and other estuarine life fun and fascinating artworks and videos.

#### **EXPERIENCE A SHOW AT** THE TURNAGE THEATRE

The Historic Turnage Theatre is the centerpiece of the arts community in Washington, which is a hub for the arts in eastern North Carolina. The theater offers a variety of programs ranging from monthly art exhibits and theater performances to photography shows, arts camps for youth, and festivals featuring art, music and wildlife.

#### **LEARN RICH HISTORY AT THE UNDERGROUND** RAILROAD MUSEUM

Come listen to cofounder Leesa Jones tell the story of how freedom seekers used creative communication tactics when traveling the Underground Railroad through Washington.



Visit the Aurora Fossil Museum where you'll find fossil displays, a shark hall, a world class collection of gems and minerals as well as a fluorescent mineral room. You can even dig for your own fossils in the Pits of the Pungo!





#### HISTORIC BATH

For a relaxing day trip or a quiet escape, discover North Carolina's oldest town - a community that, despite its wild history, remains relatively unchanged population-wise from its original incorporation over 300 years ago.

#### HIT THE BEACH

# Arts & Culture Trail

### 2 Days // 16 Stops

WASHINGTON, NC | Search for treasure in the place Blackbeard called home. Take a few selfies with artistic crabs. Step into the past at the underground Railroad Museum. You'll find it all on the Arts & Culture Trail of the Pamlico. There are over 15 stops covering all of Beaufort County. So, bring your curiosity and give yourself a couple of days.

#### DAY 1 **AURORA FOSSIL MUSEUM**

2 Hours

Watch out for that Megalodon! Prehistoric shark teeth, shells, coral, and other fossils are yours for the finding at the fossil pits outside of the Aurora Fossil Museum. Bring your own sand sifter and walk away with a discovery. Inside the museum learn about the unique natural history of the coastal plains of North Carolina. Explore exhibits featuring Native American artifacts, fossils of all shapes and sizes. You may even walk away with your own precious gem.

#### **COFFEE ARTS**

Peer through the giant glass storefront windows at Swindell's; you never know what you'll find. Coffee shop and culture collide in this historic building that hosts a gathering spot for the community, a gallery, and a host to guest artists in its studio space. Check the local calendar for pop-up events.

#### **BATH HISTORIC SITE & MUSEUM**

1 Hour

There are lots of "firsts" in Bath: The first town in North Carolina. This one marks the site of the first public library in the American colonies. Given by the Reverend Thomas Bray to St. Thomas Parish in 1700, the collection of books included works about contemporary interests and religious works-including Gilbert Towerson's Application of the Church Catechism, the only book from the original collection known to exist today. Can you imagine the late fees if you forgot to bring that book back on time?

#### SHOWBOAT AUTHOR, EDNA FERBER MARKER

The James Adams Floating Theater docked in Bath in the 1920s. It was a virtual floating fun house and the inspiration for the best-selling novel Show Boat. Novelist Edna Ferber boarded the James Adams while researching her book and ended up working. eating, playing, and rehearsing with the company aboard. Show Boat was eventually adapted into a musical and three motion pictures.

#### **BLACKBEARD MARKER**

1 Hour

Walk in the footsteps of a pirate. Legend has it that Blackbeard (aka Edward Teach) was a tall, murderous pirate whose shiny black beard smoked when he walked. The infamous captain of the Queen Anne's Revenge settled in Bath after running his ship aground on a sandbar in Beaufort. Here, he received a royal pardon, which he promptly squandered by returning to the sea where he continued to rob and plunder with three pistols strapped across his chest. Skulk around the town he called home . . . before he lost his head in a bloody battle off Ocracoke Island in 1718.

#### ST. THOMAS **EPISCOPAL CHURCH**

St. Thomas Church, in the heart of Historic Bath, has been an active parish for more than 300 years. That's a lot of "Amens." The church was built in 1734 and is the oldest church building in the state. Services are held in the historic structure every Sunday as well as other times throughout the year. The St. Thomas family welcomes visitors and those searching for a new home to worship.

#### LAWSONS WALK SIGN

1 Hour

Imagine mapping out a plan for your own town and picking where houses would be built and where the main street would lie. Think historical HGTV series, before there was HGTV or even TV. That's what John Lawson did for Bath. Lawson was a Naturalist, an explorer, and he was the Surveyor General for the Lords Proprietors. Known as the town's father, Lawson traveled the interior of the Carolina colony in the 1700s. He described the 550-mile journey in A New Voyage to Carolina, published in 1709. Lawson was killed by Tuscarora Indians while exploring the Neuse River in 1711.

#### DAY 2

#### HISTORIC TURNAGE THEATRE

Step inside the Turnage Theatre and you're transported back to the 1920s. Art Deco chandeliers illuminate the 432-seat theatre. A grand stage awaits the next magical performance. You can almost hear the cheers, laughter and applause of the audience. Visitors can tour the restored property by appointment. The Arts Council has transformed the space at the front of the theater into an art Gallery featuring the work of local craftsmen. So even when there is not a performance, there is always something creative to experience.

#### **HAVENS GARDEN** WHEEL AND PARK

1 Hour

Take a selfie with one of Washington's most beloved landmarks: the Havens Garden Wheel. A relic from an area lumbervard, the giant steel wheel sits at the water's edge just before the bridge on Park Drive. Kids of all ages love to climb it and at sunset it makes a fantastic silhouette against the Pamlico. Check out the inclusive playground while you're there, and watch for turtles and crabs waddling out of the river. 1001 Park Dr

#### UNDERGROUND RAILROAD MUSEUM

Corner of Main and Gladden Streets, Washington, NC See the faces. Read their stories of sacrifice. Understand what it took to escape from slavery. Climb aboard the restored Seaboard Coast Line Railroad Caboose and enter a pictorial history of slavery in Washington and Beaufort County. Part of the National Park Service "Underground Railroad Network to Freedom," this small museum has a big impact.

#### **CRAB TRAIL**

1 Hour

Want to go on a crab hunt? Not for the kind you can eat, but for giant, vibrantly painted crab statues that make a great selfie partner. In 2006, 32 local artists each painted one of these large, fiberglass crabs as part of an outdoor community art project. The project raised a substantial sum for local charities. Though many have been "adopted" and moved out of town, you can still find six along the waterfront area, each decorated in a unique way. 223 E Water St Washington, NC 27889

### THE LEMONADE ART GALLERY

1 Hour

Making lemons into lemonade is the specialty at Lemonade Art Gallery. The five artist-owners of Lemonade were inspired to open their own space after a gallery hosting them closed unexpectedly. #### **HIGHWAYS**

Supporting the movement of people and things, Highway US 264 East/West is a four-lane divided highway that connects Beaufort County to Greenville and beyond to I-95 and I-40.
US 17 North/South is a four lane divided highway through Beaufort County and partially four-lane to parts of Norfolk, VA and Morehead City, NC.
The quickest way to Highway 95 is

in Wilson, NC which is 65.4 miles

away.

#### **PASSENGER AIR**

**KOCW** Washington-Warren Airport (KOCW) exists to be a gateway to the City of Washington and Beaufort County, while being a beacon of premier service and hometown hospitality to the aviation community. 




